







The Pathway Program

The Christian Brothers College (CBC) and Flinders University Higher Education Pathway Program offers students a unique opportunity to seamlessly transition from secondary education to higher learning, creating an integrated academic experience.

By completing Research Project Stage 2 / Activating Identities and Futures (AIF), the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE), and prerequisite school subjects, students are **guaranteed** entry into a variety of specialised programs at Flinders University.

The program offers three tailored pathways: the **Sport Pathway** (**Diploma**), **Sport Pathway** (**Bachelor**), and **Business Pathway** (**Bachelor**), ensuring students can pursue their passions with confidence and direction.

A Guaranteed Pathway

Access to Degrees Irrespective of ATAR

Students who pursue one of the Flinders University pathways gain access to specific degrees, regardless of their Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR). This unique feature allows students to focus on their academic and practical achievements without the pressure of ATAR-based entry requirements.

Meeting Requirements is Essential

To qualify for the guaranteed entry into these degrees, students must meet all necessary prerequisites, including achieving a minimum grade of B- in prerequisite Year 12 subjects. This ensures that students are well-prepared and meet the academic standards required for higher education.

Exclusive to CBC, with a Focus on Soccer

The Sports Pathway (Diploma) is offered exclusively through Christian Brothers College, particularly for students involved in the Soccer Program. This partnership creates a specialised route for CBC students to transition into higher education with a focus on sports-related programs.







Comprehensive Support in Subject Selection (Years 9-11)

Students are guided through the subject selection process in Years 9, 10, and 11 to ensure they are on the right track to meet the pathway requirements. This proactive approach keeps their options open and ensures they are supported at every stage of their academic journey, aligning their choices with future university and career goals.

Meeting VET Requirements through CBC Advantage Line

CBC offers students the ability to fulfill Vocational Education and Training (VET) requirements through the exclusive CBC Advantage Line. Students can complete the Certificate III in Business or Certificate III in Sport Coaching as part of the school's subject offerings. These qualifications are delivered on-site, which is unique to CBC and adds considerable value to the program. It is important to note that these Certificate III courses come with an additional cost.

Students achieving the required Grade Point Average (GPA) from their Diploma studies will allow them to apply to transfer into other courses, such as Bachelor of Health Sciences / Master of Physiotherapy.



The Sports Pathway (Diploma) integrates the knowledge of Flinders academic studies with practical training and experience from real South Australian Clubs including Port Adelaide Football Club, Adelaide United Football Club and the South Australian Cricket Association.
